9 AM–11:30 Mass choir rehearsal
11:30-12:30 Choirs gather all their belongings and clean out their rehearsal rooms
12:30-1:00 Singers and adult chaperones walk to Joaquin Miller Park
Conductors leave for Conductors' Banquet
1:00 – 4:00 Festival Picnic
4:00-4:30 Singers and adult chaperones walk back to LDS Interstake Center
4:30 Conductors return to picnic site from banquet
4:30 Host families pick up singers at the picnic site.
6:15 Hosts drop adults off at First Congregational Church in Berkeley
6:15 Call time for singers at First Congregational Church in Berkeley, host families drop singers
7:30-9:30 Community Competition Concert, First Congregational Church, Berkeley*
9:30 PM Host families pick up singers and return home.

Saturday, July 18th

8:45 AM Adults arrive at Zellerbach Hall, Berkeley. **Singers should have concert attire with them if they are not returning to their homestays prior to closing concert.**
9:00 Host families drop adults and singers off at Zellerbach Hall, Berkeley
9 AM - noon Rehearsal at Zellerbach Hall
Noon – 2:00 Rehearsal time for competition winners who will be performing a musical set in the Closing Concert
Host families will pick up these singers at 2 PM at Zellerbach. Host families' choice: unscheduled time until 6 PM. Adults- free time. Singers and adults should be dressed in concert clothes prior to arriving for closing concert.
OR
Noon – 6:00 Host families pick up singers at Zellerbach Hall. Host families' choice: unscheduled time. Adults-free time. Singers and adults should be dressed in concert clothes prior to arriving for closing concert.
5:30 Adults leave Executive Inn Suites for Zellerbach Hall
6:00 Call time at Zellerbach Hall (singers arrive dressed in concert clothes)
7:30 – 9:00 Closing Concert at Zellerbach Hall*
9:30 – 11:00 Closing party, Zellerbach Hall
11:00 PM Host families pick up singers at Zellerbach Hall, return home
Adults return to Executive Inn Suites.

5:30 AM Host families drop singers at Executive Inn Suites in Oakland for return home
8:20 Leave San Francisco on Southwest Flight 2009 to Denver
11:50 AM Arrive Denver International Airport
